



IBT TOEFL
INTERNET-BASED TEST OF ENGLISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE

DESCRIPTION:

The purpose of the TOEFL test is to evaluate the English proficiency of people whose native language is not English. The test uses a multiple-choice format to measure the ability to understand North American English.

The test consists of four sections:

- * *Listening Comprehension*
- * *Speaking*
- * *Reading Comprehension*
- * *Test of Written Expression (TWE)*

FACTS ABOUT TOEFL:

- * *It is given at more than 1,275 test centers in 180 countries.*
- * *TOEFL scores are required for purposes of admission by more than 2,400 colleges and universities in the USA and Canada.*
- * *Many government agencies, scholarship programs, and businesses use the TOEFL scores to evaluate English proficiency*

TOEFL EXAM PREPARATION COURSES
