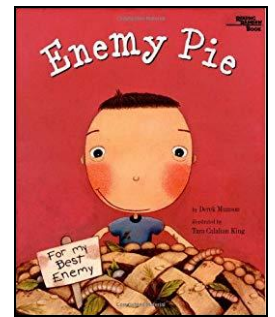


PRE-STORY ACTIVITIES FOR "Enemy Pie" By Derek Munson & Tara Calahan King



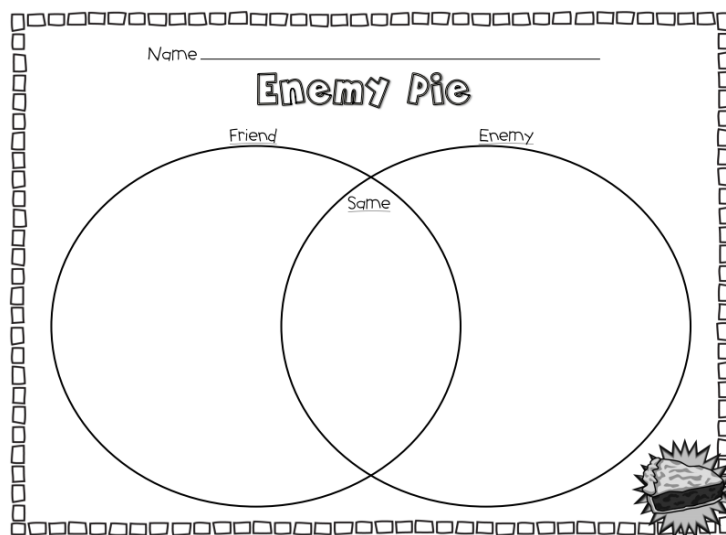
STORY SUMMARY:
