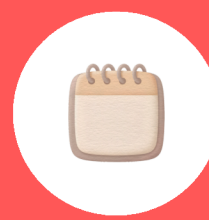
US & Canadian English teachers

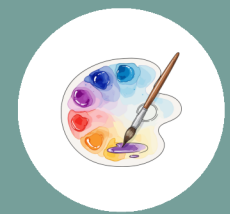
Drama

Our cafeteria has fridges and microwaves to store and heat the food.

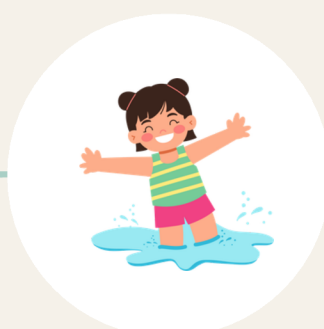
